IMPORTANT REMINDERS

SPARE HATS- Spare hats get assigned to a child if they do not have a Cottage hat so we can keep all children sun safe and differentiate who is in the care of Kids Cottage. Please look through your child's bag and around your home for any spare hats that your child may have brought home. If you have had any spare hats find their way home, please return them to Kids Cottage so we can keep all our children sun safe whilst at Cottage. If you are needing to purchase a new Cottage hat for your child, please let us know and we can provide your child with a new hat and charge the \$9 to your account.

14 DAY CANCELLATION POLICY- Kids Cottage has a 14-day cancellation policy which means that if you wish to amend or end your permanent bookings or remove a one-off day you will need to give us 14 days' notice. If you miss the 14-day window to remove your bookings those bookings will be marked as absent, and you will still be charged.

Xplor Home App User Guide

Your Xplor Home app does much more than just allow you to sign in and out your children from Kids Cottage. It is your one stop shop for all things Kids Cottage allowing you access to your bookings, payment details, personal details, and observations on your child's time at Kids Cottage.

Did you know that you can mark your child/ren as absent via the app? It is easy and time saving as we no longer require you to send us an email or give us a call. All you need is to open your Xplor Home app, navigate to the sign in tab which will show you your current bookings for the day. If you click the expand button in the top right-hand corner of the booking it will open up more details and at the bottom right-hand corner, you will see the 'absent' button to mark your child as absent.

Have you made a casual booking via the Xplor app yet? It is a quick and easy process and again saves time on sending an email! If you go to the bookings tab in the app it will display all your current bookings at Kids Cottage. To request an extra booking all you need to do is click on the date you wish to make the booking and then click the '+new' button in the top right-hand corner of the page and select 'booking' in the pop up. Available sessions will be viewable for that day, please select the room and time you wish to book. Once selected, click on the pram icon in the top right-hand corner to go to the summary screen and if all details are correct click request. (Note casual booking are for BSC and ASC only, VAC bookings are still via email)

Is someone regularly collecting your child other than a parent or guardian? If so, you can add them as a hub guest so they to will be able to sign your child out of Kids Cottage on the Ipads. To add a Hub Guest, go to the Hub Guests tab, click '+new' in the top right-hand corner and add in their name and email address. They guest will receive an email asking them to create a password which they will use to sign out on the Ipads.
