We have had a busy term at Kids Cottage with lots of highlights along the way. Term 2 Reminders

Winter: As we head into the winter months at Kids Cottage it is getting darker earlier resulting in a dramatic drop in temperature through the afternoon. Our winter policy states that no child can be outside after 5pm without a jumper during the winter months. If your child/ren are going to be at Cottage past 5pm, can you please ensure they have a jumper in their bag, so they do not miss out on the group activities with their friends. When it becomes too dark to be outside the children will be transitioned down to the hall between 5pm and 5:45pm. If you are collecting within these times, please show patience as it can take a bit longer for your child to make their way back up to Kids Cottage to be collected.

Casual Bookings: As numbers are picking up for after school care our availability for casual, last-minute bookings are reducing with Tuesday and Thursday afternoons being our busiest. If you are needing a casual after school care booking on either a Tuesday or Thursday afternoon, please provide us with as much notice as possible to ensure we have space for your child. If booking in on the day we may not have space available for your child/ren.

July Vacation Care Highlights

STAFFING SPOTLIGHT

Kids Cottage Middle Harbour is currently on the hunt for new Educators to join our close-knit team! We wanted to share this opportunity with our Middle Harbour Community and see if anyone knows someone who would be perfect for the role!

The Kids Cottage Middle Harbour is an Out of School Hours Care service providing care for the community of Middle Harbour Public School along with the wider community over Vacation Care.

The Casual position of **Educator**, works directly with children and with the team to manage the delivery of a high quality, stimulating Out of Hours program that meets the social, emotional and developmental needs of the children attending the centre. Whilst working at the service you will be required to work spilt shifts 7am-9am and 2:30pm to 6:30pm. During our vacation care programs shifts vary from 8:00am to 6:00pm.

BASC Voucher Program

Over the last year the Department of Education has taken steps to increase access to Before and After School Care including the development of the BASC Voucher Program which will offer families a \$500 voucher per child to support the cost of accessing BASC services.

Families can claim the voucher from Service NSW between the 28th of February and the 30th of September 2022 and must be redeemed at a participating Before and After School Care Service by the 31st of December 2022. You can claim your vouchers from 28th of February through the Service NSW app on your your smartphone or by following the verification steps as outlined on the Service NSW website http://www.service.nsw.gov.au/basc-voucher

Once you have received your vouchers redeeming them at Kids Cottage is a simple process. There will be a QR code and unique single use code attached to the voucher much like Dine and Discover. You can either bring the vouchers to Kids Cottage and let us scan the vouchers through our Service NSW Business app or send through your unique single use code on the voucher for us to enter it into the Service NSW business app manually. Once entered and linked to Kids Cottage we will place a \$500 credit onto your account for you to use for future bookings.

This credit can be used for Before School Care, After School Care and even Vacation Care bookings by all families who are enrolled at an Out of School Hours Care Service.

Child Safe Standard 6:

Processes to respond to complaints of child abuse (or other concerns) are child focused.

Through implementing the Child Safe Standard 6, we have embedded a child focused complaint process that supports children who are exposed to risks of harm and encourages them to speak up.

This is reflected in our complaint handling policy that clearly outlines roles and responsibilities, approaches to dealing with different types of complaints and obligations to act and report.

Our management team fosters a culture where complaints are taken seriously and all Educators take responsibility for the safety of children.

We want all children to feel safe to raise concerns about themselves or their friends creating an environment where they feel supported and heard.

QIP Development:

Our **Q**uality Improvement **P**lan is a selfassessment tool that guides us to assess our performance in delivering quality education and care helping us plan for future improvement.

It is updated annually allowing us the opportunity to reflect on the improvement plan set from the year before and then create a new plan for the year ahead.

Part of our QIP development is gaining feedback from families. This term we would like feedback from families on further links into our local community.
